LAY MINISTRY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Revised Guidelines for Academic Year 2006-2007

The Lay Ministry Scholarship Fund was founded and initiated by Bishop Raymond Lucker in January of 2000. It began with a personal donation and the fund was expanded with gifts at his 25th Anniversary celebration and at his funeral as one of the designated charities. It was clear from Bishop Lucker's leadership that ongoing Faith Formation was a central focus and leadership development was essential.

The Lay Ministry Scholarship Fund is to provide assistance to help in the qualifying formation/training of personnel currently in lay ecclesial ministries in the Diocese of New Ulm.

Eligibility Criteria

- Funds are available to the following individuals serving in ministries in the Diocese of New Ulm: Catholic school administrators and teachers, religious education directors, catechists, youth ministers, liturgists, and pastoral care providers.
- Financial need is demonstrated.
- Individuals will be working toward a degree, certification, or qualification in a theological field or Catholic school administration or ministry formation program.
- Programs considered eligible include:
 - Catholic college or university theology course
 - a Ministry Formation program
 - 2 day minimum workshop or institutes
 - a course required for school administrators.
- Applicant intends to continue ministry in the Diocese of New Ulm.
- Pastor's or Pastoral Administrator's letter of recommendation that will verify appointment to the ministry specified.
- Length of service in the Diocese of New Ulm will be considered.

Benefits

- The accumulated interest from the fund will be distributed.
- Scholarship monies will be granted based on the money available from the fund.
- The monies will be distributed depending on the number of applicants and their need.
- The minimum scholarship will be \$200.00.
- The maximum scholarship granted in one year would be \$1000.00.
- A limit of \$4000 will be awarded to an individual.

Application

- A complete application includes:
 - The application form.
 - Pastoral leader's letter of recommendation.
 - A concise essay about your educational and ministerial goals, and how the program will help you meet those goals.
 - Statement of financial need.
- Application deadlines are March 15 and September 15.

Scholarship Committee

- The five members of the Lay Ministry Scholarship Committee are appointed by the Bishop and the Committee is composed of one diocesan staff person, one priest/pastoral administrator, one Diocesan Evangelization and Catechesis Committee member, and two at large members.
- The Lay Ministry Scholarship Committee will meet to review the applications and make recommendations to the Bishop of the Diocese of New Ulm.
