ADDENDUM TO JOINT REPORT OF BALLOT TABULATION

<u>Unreported Ballots.</u> The court's Order (I) Approving Disclosure Statement; (II) Approving Solicitation Packages and Distribution Procedures; (III) Approving Ballot Forms and Plan Voting Procedures; (IV) Fixing the Voting Deadline; and (V) Approving Procedures for Vote Tabulation (the "<u>Procedures Order</u>") [Docket No. 343] provides that if a properly completed, executed, and timely received ballot does not indicate either acceptance or a rejection of the plan, the ballot will not be counted or considered for any purpose in determining if the plan has been accepted or rejected. Two ballots were received from holders of Class 4 Claims that did not indicate acceptance or rejection of the Plan and are thus not included in the Ballot Report.

Superseded Ballot. The Procedures Order further provides that if more than one ballot is cast by a holder of a claim, the last ballot received before the voting deadline will be deemed to reflect the voter's intent and thus supersede any prior ballots. One of the holders of a Class 2 Claim initially submitted a ballot voting to reject the plan, which was received on January 2, 2020, but the same holder later submitted a ballot voting to accept the plan, which was received on February 6, 2020. Pursuant to the Procedures Order, the initial ballot is not included in the Ballot Report.
