Statement from Bishop Chad W. Zielinski regarding the appointment of Bishop-elect Steve Maekawa to the Diocese of Fairbanks, Alaska

On behalf of the faithful of the Diocese of New Ulm, I extend my sincere congratulations to Bishop-elect Steve Maekawa on his appointment as the Bishop of Fairbanks, Alaska. Bishop-elect Maekawa is an excellent choice by Pope Francis to serve the largest diocese in the United States, which I served before being appointed Bishop of New Ulm.
