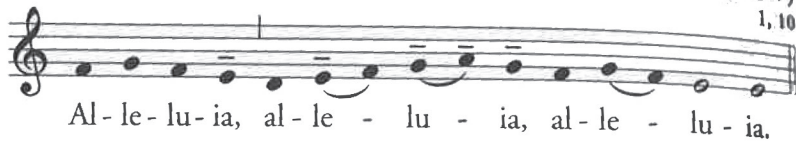
- 8 *If you conquer, I will make you a pillar in the temple of my God; *
